

## Alberta Owned Racehorses in Canadian Racing News

The Alberta owned filly **INGLORIOUS** created headlines in Canadian horse racing news when she became the first filly to win the Queen's Plate since Dancethruthedawn in 2001. The three year old filly by juvenile sire HENNESSY won three major stakes races at Woodbine including the La Lorgnette Stakes, the Woodbine Oaks and the Queen's Plate. Inglorious earned \$1,129,705 in 2011 increasing her career winnings to \$1,307,032 for Sherwood Park, Alberta based owners, Vern and Donna Dubinsky. INGLORIOUS will likely be a strong contender for the Canadian Horse of the Year title when the 2011 Sovereign Award winners are decided. The Sovereign award voters go to the online polls in January and the winners are announced at the 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Sovereign Awards on Thursday April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

The Dubinsky's previously owned the racehorse **CARELESS JEWEL** who was sold at the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky November Mixed Sale for \$1.95 Million. CARELESS JEWEL earned over one million dollars in her race career that included five first place finishes in seven starts. Prior to CARELESS JEWEL, the Dubinsky's best race horse was the Alberta bred and raced filly by Magic Prospect, **KAYLEE'S MAGIC**.

Ironically, INGLORIOUS may be facing competition for the Canadian Horse of the Year title from another Alberta owned three year old **PENDER HARBOUR**. The colt by the sire Philanthropist, earned \$861,092 in 2011 with victories in the Prince of Wales Stakes, the Breeders' Stakes and the Bunt Lawless Stakes. Pender Harbour is owned by Bob and Roberta Giffin, Denny Andrews and Sandra Lazaruk all of Edmonton, Alberta. Andrews is also the co-owner of the Freshman Sire Philanthropist - the sire of Pender Harbour.

The four year old colt **ATLANTIC HURRICANE** had an impressive 2011 season winning the Seaway Stakes, the Ontario Fashion Stakes and the Bessarabian Stakes. He won six of his eight starts in 2011 adding \$391,033 to his career earnings and bringing his overall lifetime earnings to \$434,553. The colt by Halo's Image is owned by Albertans Roy and Brent McLellan, Carl Hollick and transplanted Albertan Stuart Simon.
